
About Our Park

THE PRO’S VIEW:


Continuing our series on how to best manage your play at Monterey Pines Golf Course, this month our focus is on:

Hole #13 466 yards, Par 5

“This beautiful, tree-lined fairway begins with a difficult drive that requires a right-to-left shaped tee shot. If the drive is off line, it could end up out of bounds on either side of the fairway. The second shot determines the fate of the golfer.

If reaching the green in two shots is out of the question, it is very important to keep your second shot to the left side of the fairway. This will give you a clear opening to the green which is protected by a sand trap and out of bounds on the left, and huge Monterey pine trees and out of bounds on the right.”

Remember, have fun, play smart and (most of all) enjoy the game of golf! Join us again next month when we talk about how to approach hole number fourteen. Just one last quick reminder, when you finish playing a hole, please repair your ball marks and divots. Thanks! We look forward to seeing you on the course at Monterey Pines!



The Rules of Golf: Rule 19. Ball in Motion Deflected or Stopped

Definitions: An “*outside agency*” is any agency not part of the match or, in stroke play, not part of the *competitor’s side*, and includes a *referee*, a *marker*, an *observer* and a *forecaddie*. Neither wind nor water is an *outside agency*.

“**Equipment**” is anything used, worn or carried by or for the player except any ball he has played at the hole being played and any small object, such as a coin or a tee, when used to mark the position of a ball or the extent of an area in which a ball is to be dropped. **Equipment** includes a golf cart, whether or not motorized. If such a cart is shared by two or more players, the cart and everything in it are deemed to be the **equipment** of the player whose ball is involved except that, when the cart is being moved by one of the players sharing it, the cart and everything in it are deemed to be that player’s **equipment**.

19-1. By Outside Agency: If a ball in motion is accidentally deflected or stopped by any *outside agency*, it is a *rub of the green*, no penalty is incurred and the ball shall be played as it lies except:

- ? If a ball in motion after a *stroke* other than on the *putting green* comes to rest in or on any moving or animate *outside agency*, the player shall, *through the green* or in a *hazard*, drop the ball, or on the *putting green* place the ball, as near as possible to the spot where the *outside agency* was when the ball came to rest in or on it, and
- ? If a ball in motion after a *stroke* on the *putting green* is deflected or stopped by, or comes to rest in or on, any moving or animate *outside agency* except a worm or an insect, the *stroke* shall be cancelled, the ball replaced and the *stroke* replayed.
- ? If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted.

(Player’s ball deflected or stopped by another ball – see Rule 19-5.)
