



GOLF TIP The Grip



The right hand grip is primarily in the fingers, for two reasons. First, a finger grip promotes maximum “feel” or “touch”. Second, a finger grip allows the right hand to whip the clubhead through the ball with a powerful slinging action. Imagine the way a baseball pitcher generates speed by grasping the ball near the end of his fingers - he’d never get much speed if he held it in his palm. Gripping the club in the fingers of the right hand allows that hand to work in much the same way.

THE PRO’S VIEW:



We continue to advise you on how to best manage your play at Monterey Pines Golf Course. You will only see the tougher Par 3 holes in this column as this month we work on:

HOLE #4: 192 YARDS, PAR 3
This hole is tough! It’s long and features two huge Monterey cypress trees that guard the left side of the green. The right side is trapped, leaving the golfer with only a small opening to hit to the green. Another problem can also occur. Most golfers either slice or face a golf ball, which is affected then by the prevailing afternoon breeze off the ocean.

There are two shots to play:

“The first shot option (geared to the more accomplished golfer) is to hit a high hard drive at the right side of the bunker (sand trap) bringing it right-to-left to the green”.

“With the second shot option, the average golfer, using a club that will keep the ball low, can hit the ball and let it roll to the green. If it does not hit the green, at least there is the opportunity to chip it close and save par.”

GOLF RULE

27/16 Ball declared lost is found before another ball put into play

Question: A player searched for his ball for two minutes, declared it lost and started back to play another ball at the spot from which the original ball was played. Before he put another ball into play, his original ball was found within the five-minute period allowed for search. What is the ruling?

Answer: A player cannot render a ball lost by declaration - see definition of “Lost Ball”. The original ball remained in play - see definition of “Ball in play.”
