This month's Golf Rule:

"Doubt About Whether the Ball is in the Water Hazard"

If you hit your shot in the direction of a water hazard and can't find the ball, you can't assume it's lost. There must be some kind of evidence that it actually is lost in the water hazard and not lost elsewhere. Evidence being you saw the ball go in the hazard. Without evidence, the ball must be considered lost elsewhere and not in the water hazard.

GOLF TIP

What the Pro's do?

Practice the short game. 70% of golf shots are played from 100 yards and in. The pros practice more on their short game than another part of the game.

Practice after your round. Most golfers will hit some balls before their round to loosen up. But after the round they will settle their bets and go home. The best time to practice is after the round to work on the areas that gave you the most trouble during your round.

One shot at a time. The Pros will always focus on the shot at hand. No matter how bad the last shot was it is over and nothing can be done. So focus on the current shot because that is the only shot you have control over.
