

If your child is between the ages of six weeks and five years and you are looking for a high quality, nurturing early childhood experience ~ the Child Development Center (located in La Mesa Village) is the place for you! We offer full-time child care. We maintain a wait list for full-time care.

Life Skills Readiness Program ~ The Life Skills Readiness Program is a part-day program for children 3 to 5 years old. Prepare your child for school and give yourself some time to take care of some errands. Our Life Skills Readiness program offers a developmentally appropriate curriculum in a stimulating environment within our accredited child development program. SCIENCE BY DISCOVERY

Children learn scientific concepts through real experiences such as playing in the mud, holding a rabbit, walking in the rain, jumping in leaves, and playing with worms. For young children, science is a natural and spontaneous process - and sometimes a messy one. Teachers and parents can enhance children's understanding of science by allowing kids to "mess around" in the real world.

Our programs promote the development of the processes that are integral to science: observing, classifying, communicating, measuring, inferring, and predicting. The following are examples of ways science is used every day: Observation skills-examining rocks or leaves or by noticing the different sizes of shadows; Classifying skills-sorting buttons or shapes and by recognizing similarities and differences in objects; Measurement skills-measuring how much a plant has grown or by using blocks to measure a friend's height; and, Inference and Prediction skills - guessing what is inside a box or what will happen when water is poured over ice.


Including children in preparation for supper, planting a flower bed, or building a bookshelf provides additional opportunities for children to experience science firsthand. A young child's natural curiosity and willingness to explore new things make the early years the perfect time for beginning science curriculum.






