

The Shape of Things

Shapes are all around us, in natural objects, architecture, signs, and even in numerals and letters we use. Shape knowledge underlies algebra, geometry, and other domains of higher mathematics. This complex knowledge begins with the very simple foundation of recognizing simple shapes- circles, squares, triangles, ovals, rectangles, and diamonds. Children can begin to notice these shapes in the world around them, and you can help them to do so.




BICYCLE RENTALS


The Monterey Bay Athletic Club has adult sized bicycles available for rental by fitness center eligible patrons to meet their transportation needs or for recreational riding.



To access the website you must first be an authorized user and enrolled in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS). Authorized users are active Duty Military/Uniformed Services Members, Selected Reserve/Guard personnel, Retired Military, Direct Hire Appropriated Fund DOD Civilian Employees, non-appropriated fund civilian employees, certain DOD contractors in Hawaii and overseas, and the family members of the above who have been issued DOD ID cards. Authentication is accomplished by verifying the information contained in DEERS.
